- 2009 was best year ever for eComStation
- 2010 turnover of eComStation 3 x 2009
- Trend in 2011 continues, sales to companies primarily in the US.
- New customers (companies) needing to replace Warp 3/4!
- Virtualization not an option in many cases!

eCS sold on new equipment!

- Sales to USPSS customers continue (fastforward)
- UIC: "Debbora Ahlgren, Universal Vice President of Marketing. "With the Generation 88 release, we incorporated improved usability features such as the eComStation Operating System offering a simplified user interface and improved networking and file transfer."
- Large customer with climate control equipment (not updates, new licenses!).

- eComStation 2.0 English released
- eCS 2.0 not released in German etc.:
 - Bootmanager problem with Windows Vista/7
 - Disc checker problems

New in eComstation 2.1

- Graphical Disc checker
- Airboot included to replace boot manager
 - Planned since june 2010
 - no more primary partition
 - Can boot Windows vista/7 preloads!
- eCS 2.1 released in English and German
- New Danis506.add driver

- Firefox 4 with printing and memory leaks fixed!
- New File open Dialog (not on by default)
